Ronald C Mazzochi, 87, of Bellingham Washington, passed away on July 11th. He was born on March 16, 1935 in Syracuse, NY to the late Angelo and Elvira (Bresadola) Mazzochi. Ron was self-employed and spent most of his adult life in Florida in Hallandale Beach, North Miami Beach and Fort Lauderdale. He was a member and past manager of the Tyrol Club of Solvay and its Alpine Choraliers. Ron spent his summers home in Solvay, reconnecting with friends and family, helping with the August 15th celebration, doing antique shows and bringing fireworks to set off at his great niece's birthday parties. 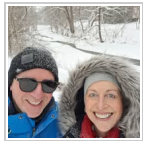
