Rudolph “Rudy” F. Capella, 94, of Solvay, passed away peacefully at Upstate University Hospital-Community General Campus on Monday August 10th. Rudy was born in Prezzo Pieve de Bono, Italy to the late Frank and Rosina (Scaia) Capella in 1925. He retired from Allied Chemical in 1985 after 36 years as a Repair Mechanic. During his working years, he was a proud member of both the Steelworkers Union of America and the United Mine Workers. 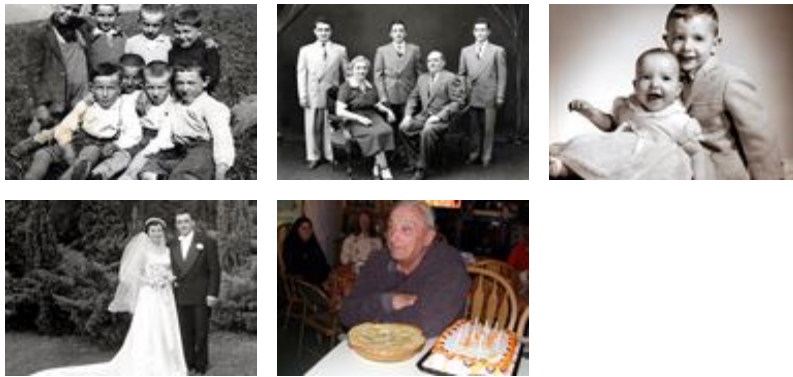
