Stephen “Steven” Bostwick, 61, of Fairmount and NYC, passed away after a sudden illness at home on Wednesday, July 23rd. Steven was a theater kid who dreamed of making it big. In Syracuse, he portrayed the blind lead character, Don Baker, in *Butterflies are Free*, and Bobby in *A Chorus Line*, among many other roles. He moved to NYC hoping to hit the big time. While there, he rubbed elbows with many famous people and appeared in the background of many movies, sitcoms and soap operas. One of his claims to fame was being the stand-in for Ted Danson. Since moving back to Syracuse in 2012, he worked in the food industry and looked forward to working at the New York State Fair every year for Syracuse’s Page One and, most recently, Horan’s food stands.

Steven was predeceased by his mother and step-father, Helen (Gavin) and Enrico Cammuso; his father, Robert Bostwick; grandparents, John and Ruth (Thompson) Gavin, and Charles and Louise (Timm) Bostwick; step-sister, Marianne (Cammuso) Herne; and step-niece, Natalie Cammuso.
