



## SYLVESTER VOLTURNO

March 13, 1929 - August 1, 2021

Sylvester Volturmo, age 92, of Camillus, NY, passed away peacefully on August 1, 2021 with his devoted and amazing wife beside him. He was being visited and comforted by family members at the time of passing. Sylvester was born March 13, 1929 to the late Giuseppe “Joseph” Volturmo and Vita Maria Lotito. 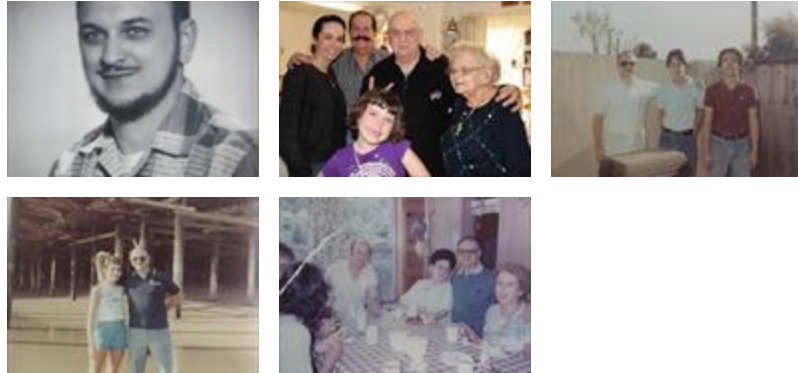
