Timothy J. Daddario, 65, suddenly passed away on April 18, 2023 in Albuquerque, NM. Born in Syracuse, New York, Tim graduated from Solvay High and Fordham University in 1981. Tim moved to New York City, then lived most of his life in the Southwest, working in the healthcare field up until his death.

A memorial service was held at Holy Family Catholic Church in Albuquerque, NM on September 15th.

Tim was predeceased by his parents Isidor and Betty. He is survived by his brothers, Daniel and David, both of Syracuse and Patrick, of South Carolina; loving nieces and nephews, Ryan, Kyle, Pat Jr., Chris, Joe, and Alicia Daddario. 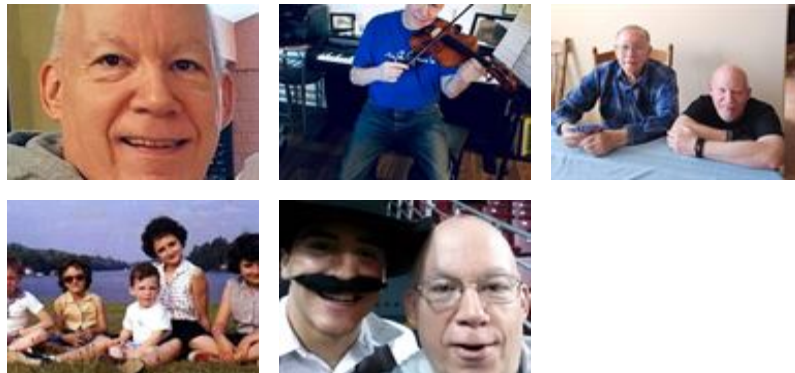
