Victor J. Gillette, Jr, 95, formerly of Solvay, passed away Monday, January 4th at Syracuse Home. He was born in Syracuse to the late Victor J. and Irene (Eno) Gillette in 1925 and graduated from Vocational High School. He was a decorated US Army Veteran of WW II serving in campaigns in Normandy, Rhineland, Ardennes and Central Europe. Victor worked as a typesetter at Syracuse Typesetting, security for Niagara Mohawk and was a special deputy with Onondaga County Sheriff's Department. He was a life member of Veterans of The Battle of The Bulge Inc, Society of The First Infantry Division-The Big Red One, Stanley B. Pennock VFW Post 2893 and Disabled American Veterans. He was a communicant of St. Marianne Cope Parish-St. Cecilia Church.

He was predeceased by his wife, Carmella "Lita" (Baratta) in 2006, his brother, Richard Gillette and sister, Delores Kornbluth.

He is survived by his daughter, Marilou (Al Noce) Barry, of Memphis; son, Victor M. Gillette, of Lakeland; 4 grandchildren, Jennifer (Mark) Simpson, Gregory Barry, Justin (Ailish) Gillette and Victor M.
