Walter J. Nendza, Jr., 87, of Baldwinsville, passed away Sunday May 2nd at Upstate University Hospital. He was born in Syracuse to the late Walter and Anne (Marko) Nendza in 1934. He was a 1956 graduate of Lemoyne College and served with the US Army from 1956–1958. Walter worked for Eastern Milk Producers Cooperative as the comptroller for 13 years and spent over 50 years in tax preparation. He was a lifetime communicant of St. Marianne Cope Parish-Our Lady of Peace Church in Lakeland. He was also a member of Lakeland Seniors, a former Little League Baseball Coach and an avid sports fan.

He is survived by his wife, the former Shirley Keefer; his brother, James (Amy) Nendza, of Nashua, NH and many nieces, nephews and cousins.
