



WILLIAM J. CAMPERLINO

October 2, 1924 - October 20, 2024

William Joseph Camperlino passed away on October 20th, 2024, at the age of 100. William is preceded in death by his parents, Joseph and Ana Mae (Petty) Camperlino, his first wife Agnes, and second wife Ana, sister Delores Pink, grandson Robert Falso, and son-in-law Al Falso.

He is survived by his four children, Kathleen Falso, William Camperlino, Diane (Ed) Brostek, and Cynthia (Brent) Millar; 11 grandchildren, 13 great-grandchildren, and 3 great-great-grandchildren.

William was born on October 2nd, 1924, in McKeesport, Pennsylvania. He was a lifetime fan of the Pittsburgh Steelers and Pittsburgh Pirates. He joined the U.S. Navy at 17 years old after his parent's signed permission. William served as a Quarter Master on the USS LSM 12 and USS LSM 137, which he survived after both were destroyed and sunk after being bombed in the South Pacific during WWII.

He was also a builder and developer with Camperlino and Fatti for over 30 years. They built over 3,000 plus homes in Central New York. He was involved with Boys Town of Italy, part owner of the Eagles Eastern National Division Hockey League, part owner of Pompey Hills Country Club, enjoyed dancing, and traveled all over the world in his lifetime.
