William F. Zuhlke, Jr, 83, of Baldwinsville, passed Saturday March 27th at home. He was born in Syracuse to the late William F. and Gertrude H. (Bleskoski) Zuhlke in 1938 and was a US Army Veteran. He worked as a truck driver for Marble Farms and later Upstate Farms for many years before retiring. William was a former travel league baseball coach, an Umpire for USSSA slow-pitch softball and was an avid sports fan, especially the Red Sox and all SU sports. He was a communicant of St. Marianne Cope Parish-St. Cecilia Church. William was predeceased by his parents and his brother, Robert J. Zuhlke of Vestal.
